3. Plan to attend a community college, four-year university, or vocational/trade school in California in the upcoming summer or fall semester of the current year.

7. A prior scholarship recipient may submit a request for an additional scholarship for an additional undergraduate college year.

The following required items MUST be combined and returned as ONE document:

1. Completed application with essay of 500 words or less. Should fit on the space provided on the application.
2. ONE letter of recommendation.
3. Resume to include list of current community service or volunteer activities including hours.
4. Copy of most recent transcript.

Please follow and complete all instructions. Incomplete applications, documents received individually, or applications received after the deadline are a few of the most common reasons applications are denied.
